Membership categories

Category 1

National membership

National organisations that pay a membership fee based on a total NZ-wide expenditure which entitles all branches, affiliates and regional offices to full membership status.

Category 2

Head office, branch and local membership

- National organisations that pay a membership fee based on their annual head office expenditure. Membership applies only to the head office.
- Branches or regional offices (whether separately incorporated or not) of a national organisation that pay a membership fee based on one branch or regional office's annual expenditure. Membership applies only to that branch or regional office.
- Local organisations that pay a membership fee based on their annual expenditure. Membership applies only to the local or regional body.
